Cllr. Walford reported that he had a meeting with Dr. Garrero from Bassaleg School to discuss the issue of the closure of the school car park. All parents now have to park on the road with many of them parking in the lay by and on the pavement. This has resulted in children crossing between parked cars; Cllr. Walford feels this must be in breach of health and safety.

Traffic Calming

The traffic survey by Newport City Council has been received and the results showed that the average speeds of vehicles through the village range from 20mph for southbound traffic to 23mph for northbound traffic. Therefore, as traffic is travelling below 30mph the Council deem it would be inappropriate to introduce a speed limit below this threshold. However, the "SLOW" sign is due to be repainted on the road.

Litter Picking

All were in agreement for the litter picking and a date was decided – the 22nd April.
