## **Agenda Item and Comments**

### **05/01/056 – Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

**05/01/063 - Meetings Reports**

Councillors attended the quarterly Liaison Meeting at Newport City Council. Again, they tabled questions on the continuing poor state of roads. The Head of Engineering, Brian Kemp, emphatically stated: “There are no plans for re-surfacing works in Michaelstone-y-Fedw area this financial year. The safety inspection was undertaken in December, and as a result minor repairs were carried out in January 2005. Pound Hill, Began Road and Tyla Lane were jet patched during May 2005.”

**05/01/064 - Chairman’s Business**

The bus service to Michaelston y Fedw is rumoured to be under threat due to the lack of use.

**Action: Clerk to find out more from Cardiff City Council**

Planning Protocol Meeting attended by Councillor Rowlands. All public buildings must satisfy wheelchair access provisions. The Community Council needs to be able to demonstrate this with the plans for a ramp into the Village Hall, and the widening of the doorway.
