05/01/056 – Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Councillors attended the quarterly Liaison Meeting at Newport City Council. Again, they tabled questions on the continuing poor state of roads. The Head of Engineering, Brian Kemp, emphatically stated: "There are no plans for re-surfacing works in Michaelstone-y-Fedw area this financial year. The safety inspection was undertaken in December, and as a result minor repairs were carried out in January 2005. Pound Hill, Began Road and Tyla Lane were jet patched during May 2005."
