5/18/01 – Minutes of the previous meeting

- The minutes of the April meeting were proposed as correct by Councillor Hallett and seconded by Councillor Schofield.

5/18/02 – Matters arising

- The “20 is plenty” signs are now in place - positive comments have been received and more signs have been requested by residents. The council agreed to buy 10 more signs.

5/18/03 – Police matters

- The monthly police report was circulated.

5/18/04 – Planning

- No applications received.

5/18/05 Roads & Rights of Way

- Water running down Began Road will be reported to Newport Council.
- Newport Council have replied regarding two items reported in October 2017. The reinstatement of road markings and the repair of the Michaelston y Fedw direction sign at the bottom of Began Road hill are on the maintenance list, but *“Due to reduced budgets our maintenance schedules are prioritised on the basis of safety critical. Therefore I am unable to confirm when this work is due to be carried out”*.

5/18/06 – Correspondence

- Welsh Government is proposing to exempt community councils from the need to appoint a Data Protection Officer as it is considered unnecessarily burdensome. However, councils will still need to pay a fee to the Information Commissioner’s Office. For this council the fee will be £40pa.

5/18/07 – Finance

- The first precept payment of £1,233 has been received from Newport Council.
- A bill of £231.64 from Newport Council for poll cards for last year’s election has been paid.

5/18/09 – Chairman’s Business

- The noticeboard at Bridge Terrace needs repair. Councillor Meringolo will look into this.
- The pads for the defibrillator need to be renewed. Pads will be ordered.
