## **07/22/01 – Minutes of the previous meeting**

The minutes of the June meeting were proposed as correct by Councillor Davies and seconded by Councillor Schofield.

## **07/22/02 – Matters arising**

- Investigation of an alternative bank account – Metro Bank can provide a Community Account at no charge. It was agreed to open an account with 3 signatories: The Clerk, Chair and Vice Chair.
- Speed warnings are only installed by Newport Council where the speed limit is 30mph or less. A letter will be sent to Newport Highways requesting that a speed limit be imposed.
- There are still about 30 oak saplings available for people to plant. This will be publicised on local WhatsApp groups etc.

## **07/22/03 – Police matters**

- A local surgery will be held on the 11<sup>th</sup> July at 11 am. Dates for August and September will also be arranged.

## **07/22/04 – Planning**

- Application 22/0493 for retention of various features at Cefn Mably Farm Park. A site meeting took place and observations have been sent to Newport Planning.

## **07/22/05 Roads & Rights of Way**

- Welsh Water have begun remedial works at Daintree House field next to Cefn Llwyd bridge. At some point they will close the road for major works but, so far, they have not specified when this will be.
