# 06/21/01 - Minutes of the previous meeting

# 0621/02 - Matters arising

- Fly-tipping:
  - The vehicle involved in fly tipping in March has now been traced after it returned to the village and was caught on CCTV. The information has been passed to Newport Council who were pleased with the information and say they intend to prosecute those concerned.
  - CCTV footage has been supplied to Natural Resources Wales regarding the recent tipping on Pound Hill. NRW intend to prosecute.
  - Recent tipping occurrences on Penylan Road and Tyla Lane were noted but the times aren't known, making it impractical to search the CCTV footage.
- Newport Council have been notified of the litter pick on the 12<sup>th</sup> June.
- Councillor Walford has repaired the community notice board at Penylan.
- CCTV warning signs have been ordered

# 06/21/04 - Planning

 No planning applications have been received this month. A pre-application consultation has been received concerning proposed changes at the telecommunications tower at Pound Hill. The Community Council has no objection but nearby residents will be informed.

## 06/21/05 Roads & Rights of Way

- Caerphilly Council have emailed to say they are setting up the necessary safety and road closure arrangements for the repairs to Michaelston Bridge.
- A recent road closure between Home Farm and Cefn Mably Farm Park caused problems because of the lack of warning when proper procedures weren't followed. The closure was portrayed as an emergency when in fact it was just for tree lopping a pole replacement and it wasn't carried out on the dates shown on the road signs. This was pointed out to Newport Council's Streetworks Supervisor.

 Thanks were received from the Village Hall CIO for the grant of £1000 towards replacing the windows.

## 06/21/07 - Finance

 The external audit Annual Return for 2020-21 had previously been circulated to councillors.
