Fancy a little bit of crafting fun as part of our Jubilee activities?

We'd like everyone to paint a stone with something that will make the finder smile and leave it in a **public place** around the village.

Then keep an eye out while you are walking for other painted stones and record any that you find.

- 1. Find a stone
- 2. Paint the stone (it would be lovely if you put your name on the back)
- 3. **May 1**st **onwards** place your stone anywhere in the village where people can find it (i.e. not in your garden!)
- 4. Look for stones others have painted
- 5. Take a picture of the stone that you have found
- 6. Email your picture to platinum@m-y-f.com
- 7. Prize for the most stones found





After the Jubilee celebrations we will collect as many stones as we can and display them in the Village Hall car park. (They may form part of a Jubilee mini garden).

Tips for painting stones. Acrylic paints seem to work best (but use whatever you have!). Ideally coat with clear varnish when finished to preserve your artwork. The internet has lots of ideas on painted stones to inspire you. The ideal size of stone is about 4-5" (big enough to see and small enough to pick up.)
