07/20/02 - Matters arising

- Fly-tipping: Newport City Council has not responded to the emails sent to Environmental Health and the Head of Legal Services. - CCTV: Councillor Davies has investigated the legal position regarding data

 registration will require nominated people to manage the system. Several cameras
 are now installed and working. Any request for data from the cameras will need to be
 submitted through an on-line form which will be logged. The Community Council will
 own the system, though MyFi has funded it so far.
